

HIGH LITTLETON MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

When one walks around the outside of the Parish Church, it is difficult to imagine from the visible signs on the surface that several thousand parishioners have been buried there. Indeed, in the period from 1740 to 1890 alone, more than 2,200 people were interred in the immediate vicinity of the Church - and burials had been taking place there for several centuries before then. Until the middle of the nineteenth century, it tended to be the graves of the well-off that were marked with an inscribed stone and thus the percentage of stones to graves was very small. In modern times, the majority of graves are marked with a stone.

Monumental inscriptions are important in that they provide evidence of the relationship of those buried in the grave and often show considerably more information than is recorded in the burial register. Some record the deaths of family members who were buried elsewhere.

One should bear in mind that not all information recorded on stones is correct. Often, stones were erected by children to the memory of their parents or by a wife to a long dead husband. In such circumstances the accuracy of the dates inscribed on the stone would have depended on the memory of the person ordering the stone. If this was many years after the event, it is not surprising that mistakes sometimes arose and there are several such examples in High Littleton.

Apart from the Quakers, who had their own burial ground in Hallatrow until 1817, the parish churchyard was the last resting place of all religious denominations in the village, including Wesleyan and Primitive Methodists, Catholics and Plymouth Brethren. In more recent times, when cremation became popular, many had their ashes interred in the churchyard or caused a plaque to their memory to be set into the wall of the churchyard.

High Littleton churchyard was almost full in 1883, when the Vestry met on 26th March to consider the question of selecting a site for a new burial ground. A decision was deferred in order to obtain more information regarding steps to be taken. For the best part of ten years the matter was regularly raised at successive Vestry meetings and a decision deferred.

Eventually the nettle was grasped and it was resolved to provide a new burial ground, for which the necessary money would be raised by voluntary subscription. Mrs. Marianna MOGG, the widow of John George MOGG, who owned much of the land in the vicinity of the Church, was approached and she agreed to sell the parish half an acre of land, which hitherto had been let to James COX of Rosewell Farm. The ground was duly purchased, levelled, fenced, sown with grass seed, paths laid out and trees planted; all for a cost of around £200. Mrs. MOGG provided a lych gate at her own expense.

By the time the new churchyard was ready, subscriptions had provided all but £50 of the cost. The published subscription list was headed by Colonel Barton Land SCOBELL of Kingwell Hall £30, Mrs. MOGG of Farrington Gurney Manor House £20, the Earl of Warwick, who owned much of Clutton parish, £10 and the vicar, Rev. A. M. FOSTER, £8. Some 140 parishioners subscribed sums from sixpence upwards.

The new churchyard was consecrated by Bishop BROMBY at a service held on 19th May 1883. Exactly one week later, Fanny BROWN of Hallatrow had the doubtful distinction of being the first person to be buried there. From then on, the only people to be buried in the old churchyard were those who already had family graves there.

The alphabetical list that follows is of monumental inscriptions gathered from a number of sources, viz:

The churchyard around the parish Church.

Inside the parish Church, on windows, walls, plaques and on furniture.

The new churchyard, including plaques on the wall, benches and lych gate.

Inside the Primitive Methodist Church.

Manuscript notes in Bristol Record Office, relating to the former Wesleyan Methodist Church, which record in detail the inscriptions on certain tablets fixed in the Church.

Neighbouring churchyards, where persons recorded as of High Littleton or Hallatrow, were buried.

The monumental inscriptions were recorded in 1991 and checked and updated in 1992. Finally, against each date of death has been recorded the date of burial. Discrepancies between the inscriptions and the burial registers have been noted.

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In carrying out this task no stone was left unturned! Some stones had fallen over and lain face down for many years. Some were completely hidden under grass and weeds or covered in ivy or moss, whilst the soil level had risen up others obscuring the lower part of the inscription. All such difficulties were overcome. Unfortunately in the case of a small number of very old stones, the elements had caused the surface to flake off, the debris had long since been swept away and little or no trace of an inscription remained. In the years ahead this process of erosion will inevitably continue, which makes the task of recording monumental inscriptions now, so important.
